



Clairemont Girls Fastpitch Softball

100-Inning Game Fundraiser

What is it?

It is a marathon softball game played between two teams (Blue & Red) consisting of CGFP players. Games in each age division will be happening simultaneously at the CGFP softball field complex.

When is it?

Saturday, March 11, 2017 beginning at 8 a.m. and ending at dusk. There are no games scheduled this day so everyone in the league can participate in this fundraiser.

Who makes up the teams?

Two teams will be formed in each division by combining individual teams into one of two larger teams whose goal will be to play as many innings as possible in a day.

How does it work?

League teams will play mini games as part of the larger game rotating in and out of the larger game every hour or two based on playing division. All divisions except the 6U division will use pitching machines to speed play. With the consistency of the pitching machines, girls will get a limited number of swings during each at bat but should be able to get tons of at-bats throughout the day.

What do the players need to do?

Between now and the date March 11, 2017, players need to go out with their sponsor sheet and solicit sponsors that will pledge \$\$ for each inning that the player's division plays that day. Sponsors may donate a flat fee if they prefer.

Why are we doing this?

First, it is a fundraiser for the league but more importantly it is a fun way for you and your parents to get to know all of the players and parents from your team. Most teams will setup pop up and organize a BBQ with their team. Secondly, we have some other cool things planned for the day. We plan to have a helmet painter, softball accessories, specialty food vendors and much more aside from lots of softball. Girls will get the chance to play lots of different positions, get tons of at-bats against the pitching machines, and learn a lot about tournament play that most of them have never had the chance to be a part of.

Where is the money going?

In years past, we've purchased and installed new bleacher canopies and clay bricks to reinforce pitching mound and batters boxes for field 2 and 4. We've also purchased pitching machine balls. We provide offensive, defensive, and pitching clinics to all players every year. We also give a softball to every player who registered at assessments. This year with the influx of rain, we are in need of dirt and soil amendments to get the fields repaired from run off. All of these things and more, can only be done with the various fundraisers we hold throughout the season.
